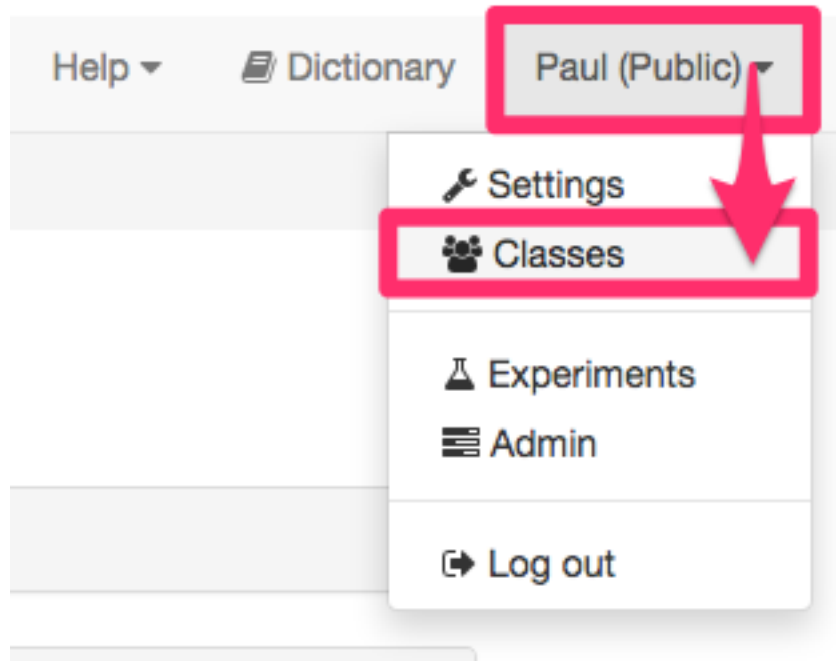
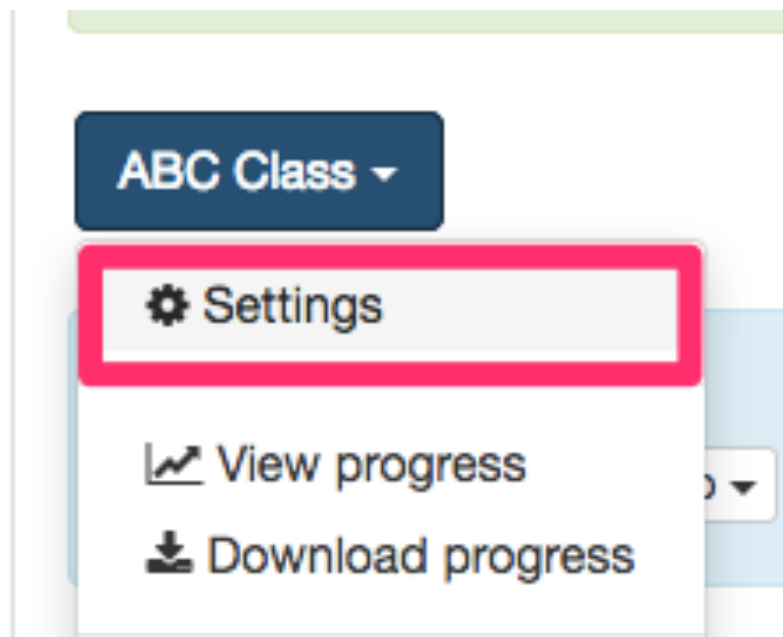


How to add YouTube Playlists to Apps 4 EFL classes

1. Access Apps 4 EFL (apps4efl.com). Click your name and then click classes. **N.B.** You must be logged in as a teacher to access this function.

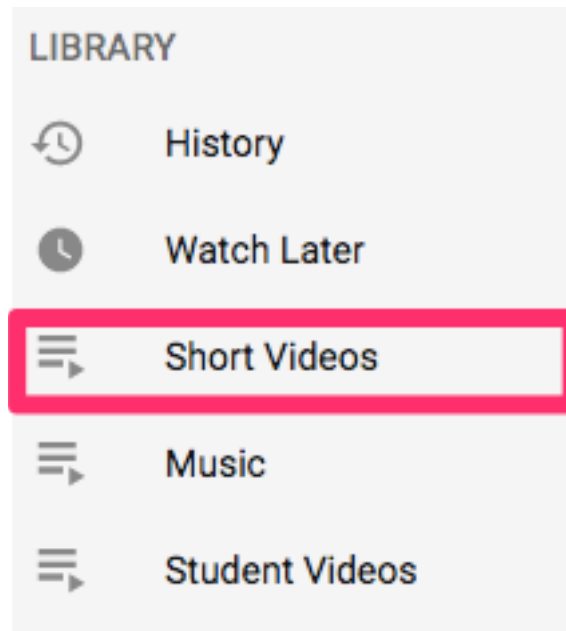


2. Click the dropdown menu for the class you wish to use and click “Settings”. **N.B.** You must have created at least one class to access this function.

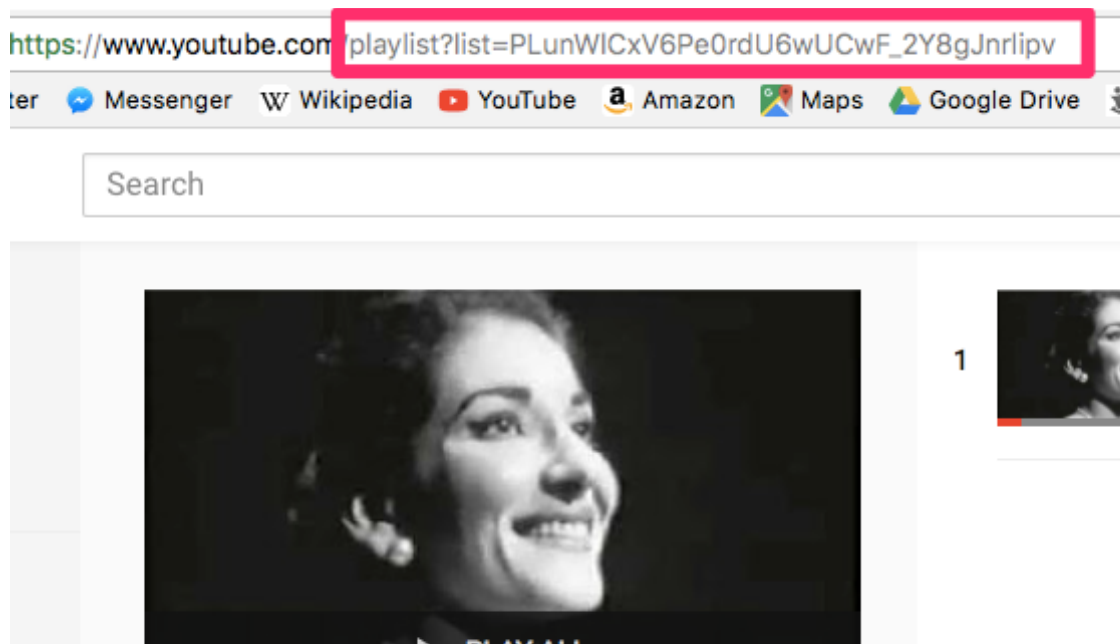


How to add YouTube Playlists to Apps 4 EFL classes

3. Access the YouTube website ([youtube.com](https://www.youtube.com)) and select the playlist you wish to use from the left side menu under “Library”. **N.B.** You must be logged into YouTube and have created at least one playlist to access this function.



4. The Playlist ID can be found in the URL at the top of the page. Copy the ID starting with “PL”:

5. Paste the ID into the Apps 4 EFL YouTube Playlist ID input box, and click “Get Playlist”:
